I called _____ on Friday night, got a man's voice (possibly her husband), called later as he said she would be in. I again reached him and we agreed for me to call Saturday night at 10:00 CDT. He never did talk to me about the subject. She and I spoke for the next 30 minutes. The substance of our conversation follows, taken from my notes.

Fr. John Howlett, SAC was very close to our family. He considered our home his second one while he was pastor. _____ We were his extended family.

He used to take _____ horseback riding. We always trusted him with the girls. When our _____ was in the second grade _____ Fr. Howlett conducted the First Communion class by himself. There were about _____ students in the class.

When we moved to _____ we would come back to visit with Fr. John. He was with the girls, playing with them away from us on occasion then. One time about two years after _____ First Communion _____ when we were

on our way back from a visit to Fr. John _____ told me that "Fr. John put his hand in my panties." I questioned her and also _____ and discovered he had done this on many occasions with the girls. _____ asked me then if this wasn't child abuse. I confronted

Fr. John with this and he did not deny it. I called the bishop in Ft. Worth and made an appointment to come to see him along with _____ and _____. I remember it as being in _____ I don't remember who I talked to. Paramount in my mind was to get Fr.

John away from little girls. While visiting with the bishop, a priest (I don't remember who.) interviewed the girls one by one, possibly to get their side of the story. Knowing what I do know, I would not have allowed him to interview the girls without me present; but he did so then. I also corresponded with a Pallotine priest in McGregor, Texas. He was acting superior of the Pallotines. After our initial talk with him, he would visit from time to time and ask how things were going. I would answer, "All right." Then I remember Fr. John went to another Church and then to the motherhouse in Michigan.

I have always disliked strong language in our home, but she uses it.

She needs counselling now and Fr. John should foot the bill because of what he did to her in her crucial formative years. She and I have locked heads since she was in the 4th grade. She is unable to let anybody do for her. "She went through this; nobody is helping her." and know how to help people, but can't help

Even though she goes regularly to Mass and Communion. I think her boyfriend is a "nice kid, though he "She is open to getting counselling, I believe," said She contacted her parish priest (not present parish, but former one),

who told her to contact the chancellor. She spoke to him and he told her to contact the bishop in Fort Worth and the religious superior of Fr. John Howlett, SAC. She called Fort Worth chancery but hasn't had a chance to call the superior in Michigan or somewhere up there.

She wanted to know what we were going to do about helping her with counselling to get over the problems she believes were caused by Fr. John 10 years ago.

I told her I would talk to our bishop and also heard her say she was going to talk to Fr. John's superior. She believed he was retired when he left the small parish following his immediate removal from the parish.

I HAD GOT TO THE CATHOLIC CENTER TODAY AND DISCOVERED THAT SHE AND THE PALLOTINE SUPERIOR HAD BEEN IN TOUCH. SHE TOLD ME THAT SHE HAD TALKED TO FR. MACNAMARA. I ASSURED HER THAT FATHER WAS MAKING CONTACT WITH FR. WEBBER TO ENLIST HIS AID IN GETTING COUNSELLING FOR HER DAUGHTER, SHE RESPONDED WITH "MY HUSBAND AND I DIDN'T DO OUR DUTY IN GETTING THE GIRLS COUNSELLING WHEN THIS HAPPENED YEARS AGO." AND SHE ALSO SAID THAT OVER THE YEARS SHE AND [REDACTED] HAVEN'T HAD THE SAME TRUST THEY USED TO HAVE IN THE CLERGY. SHE IS MAKING CONTACT WITH FR. 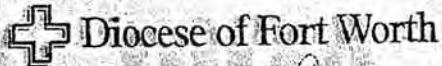


The following is an update on the situation which I mentioned to you briefly in our conversation on Monday last.

On Saturday, November 20th., [redacted] called me by telephone from [redacted]. The conversation was cordial and courteous, but somewhat demanding on her part. She informed me that her daughter [redacted] had discontinued the counselling so that there would be no more fees for counselling for the girl. She also added that her [redacted] was not interested in going to counselling either and that [redacted] wished even to talk about the alleged incident. She then hinted that she, [redacted] herself, may need some counselling.

[redacted] requested some monetary assistance for [redacted] so that she can continue her studies and move into an apartment adjacent to the College, since she now lives with her parents at some distance from her College. The amount requested was \$1,200., a \$500 deposit for the Apartment, \$500 for the first month's rent and \$200 to have the utilities connected. I also made a vague offer at paying \$100 per month to help with the rent. I did so in an effort to put a ceiling on further contributions: So there's where we're at right now.

Some good news. [redacted] graduates from College at the end of this semester with a degree in [redacted] and a good hope of employment.

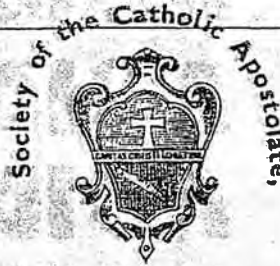

How I wish I could solve all of the world's problems. I get the most heart rending letters from Rwanda, India, Tanzania and Argentina. In all of these countries our Pallottines work as Missionaries. Here in the U.S., also, we work in the missionary or rural areas of Texas and Nevada, - so that we are not by any means a wealthy Congregation. Another aggravating factor is the advanced age of most of our Priests. Of the 20 priests we have here in the United States, 5 are in their 70s, 6, including myself, are in our 60s, 5 are in their 50s. We have 2 in their 40s and 2 in their 30s. Of the latter two, one has requested a leave of absence. Add to that the problems that come with advanced age and you will understand the stresses and concerns that I have as I try to do my job as the local superior for these 20 priests, not to mention the demands of the 4 rural parishes which I administer.

Nevertheless, even though our resources are limited, and our personnel dwindling, I do try to respond, as best I can, to all of the appeals mentioned above, - and to help you out also in the great work you are doing in caring for

in this, their time of need. Regretfully, however, I will not be able to help you all out in the future to the extent that I have been doing in the past year. It is my hope that, and I know that it is yours also, that problems will soon be solved so that he can support his wife and children as is normally done in our society.

I am so happy that is doing so well. The fact that she has given up attending Sunday Mass is not at all unique to the American youth. My brothers and sisters in Ireland report the same problems with their kids. This seems to be a phase that they grow out of, returning later to the practice of their Faith, whether on marriage, or when it comes time to baptise their own children.

In Re: Father John Howlett, SAC

On June 5, 2001 I interviewed [redacted] at [redacted]. This appointment was set up three weeks earlier to keep her from having to drive to Fort Worth to meet with me. I was in Austin for a meeting.

[redacted] states that when she was five to nine years of age Father John Howlett molested her. Her mother learned from another parent that a similar thing had happened to her daughter, and told [redacted] mother that the diocese (the Church - actually it is the Pallotine Fathers) is offering counseling. [redacted] had two purposes in talking to me. She wanted to tell a church official what had happened to her, and she wanted to request counseling. Her mother had contacted the pastor [redacted] who referred her to me.


I told [redacted] we wanted to be of any help we can, and offered her payment for six months of counseling, with the opportunity to evaluate after the six months to see if more is needed. She accepted. I asked if she knew anyone to whom she would like to go, but she did not. She is a [redacted], and at the time of her training at [redacted] had sought counseling, but [redacted] has not been in contact with anyone since [redacted]. I referred her to [redacted]. They were [redacted] to me [redacted].

[redacted] I told [redacted] that she could see either, depending on whether she wanted to see a man or a woman. After [redacted] left I called [redacted] and gave her a brief account of my conversation with [redacted], and asked her to bill me.

In addition to seeing a church official and requesting counseling, [redacted] wanted to write JH. I spoke to [redacted] about this. She agreed that it would be helpful therapeutically. I called Father John McNamara, and reported the whole story to him. He gave me JH's current address, Pallotine Fathers, Dundrum, Dublin 16, Ireland. I called [redacted] and gave her this information. JH said he would call the Pallotine provincial.

[redacted] was accompanied by a friend at my suggestion, another woman. She agreed that had accomplished all that she set out to do, namely inform a church official of what had happened, seek help with counseling and asking for JH's address in order to write him.

Father Robert Wilson asked me to call regarding an allegation that had surfaced regarding the behavior of Father John Howlett who was previously assigned there and is now in Rome under the care of his community, the Palatines. Father Wilson reminded me that there have been three previous allegations of sexual abuse by Father Howlett from women in [redacted] called [redacted] who gave me the name and telephone number of the woman alleging abuse, and I called her. The following report includes information about her and the alleged abuse:

Person reporting:

[redacted] reported that from the time she was nine until she was fourteen, between [redacted] Father Howlett pursued an increasingly intense sexual relationship with her. He began winning her confidence in traditional ways that children are drawn into sexual contact with adults, through affirmation, attention, and touching. This proceeded over the years into sexual intercourse. [redacted] parents were active in the parish, and they frequently had Father Howlett in their home or left the children with him at the rectory during evening activities at the church. In addition, the [redacted] This gave Howlett access to [redacted] in many locations which according to her, he took advantage of. She was afraid to reject him or to tell her parents, since the family was so active in the parish and "visible" in the community. As a young girl, she concluded that this was expected of her and part of the relationship with the priest. She was careful, however, never to leave her [redacted] alone with him.

It [redacted] It came hard for her to trust anyone. [redacted] on and on, since the abuse began. She developed several physiological problems as a result of the abuse, including [redacted] which began shortly before her 14th birthday. She became even more quiet and withdrawn in the family. She has been only minimally involved in the parish, although [redacted]

She seldom attends Mass. Four years ago, she decided to tell her mother [redacted] as awareness of priest sexual abuse of children began coming out in the media. Last week, [redacted] year old [redacted] expressed a wish to receive first communion. When [redacted] told [redacted] that [redacted] and her husband would need to attend a preparation session for parents, [redacted] decided to tell why [redacted] seldom comes to church.
